Qualifications: To run for an Area IV Venturing officer position, a Venturer must:

1. Be a currently registered Venturer in his or her council.
2. Be a present or past crew president, officer or a present or past chair or officer in his or her council's Venturing Officers Association (VOA) or equivalent district or council organization in his or her council.
3. Be recommended and approved by his or her council.
4. Be less than 19 years of age on April 30, 2010.

In the event a Venturer has not had the opportunity to be a crew president, officer, VOA council chair or other Venturing office for reasons such as; his/her home Crew is not structured with officers or the district and/or council VOA has not been organized, BUT the youth has demonstrated leadership and participation in crew, district and council Venturing activities and has demonstrated leadership and participation (of an equivalent nature) in some other Scouting related organization (i.e., Order of the Arrow office, Girl Scout Gold Award recipient or GSUSA troop president, or the-like.), ***the Council Scout Executive may sign below to certify other such leadership.***

7. Supports Area IV in any effort to train council Venturing officers and Advisors.
8. Promotes national, regional, and area activities, programs, and awards.
9. Agrees to wear the Venturing uniform in accordance as suggested by the regional staff.
10. Agrees to resign from office if requested by the Area IV director.
